RISKS:

Personal details such as phone number or address may represent a risk as, more generally, the sharing and dissemination of personal information and photos. Most of the teenagers do it without realizing the danger of **identity theft and enticements**.

Social media can also use children's data for commercial purposes, with the result that we are **bombarded by tons of advertising**.

Additional risks for adolescents are related to privacy and geolocation.

Every social media platform can facilitate **meetings with strangers**. Therefore sharing your location or a planned trip can be an opportunity for unwanted contact.

OPPORTUNITIES

The great success of social media is definitely associated with the great opportunities they provide through the sharing of contents with friends:

- I can stay in touch with friends / relatives living far from me
- I can make new friends
- I can share passions
- I can share homework
- I can find useful contacts for job or passions
- I can deepen my interests on dedicated pages

OBSERVATIONS

Several elements can simultaneously present risks and opportunities. For example, the possibility to share homework represents a risk to a parent / teacher, while for a teenager is an opportunity. The sharing of interests is both a risk and an opportunity, therefore it is important to be aware of risks and know tools and protection behaviors.
